

### Program Data Point 8. National Exams

This following table details the number of students/graduates that took and passed the National Counselor Examination (NCE). These primarily consist of clinical mental health counseling students, as the Educational Professional Standards Board (EPSB) of Kentucky does not require the NCE as part of its certification of school counselors. It should also be noted the program cannot account for every graduate's performance on national examinations for a myriad of reasons (e.g., student relocation, lack of access to scores from every state). However, the performance rates in the table below suggest the program provides effective instruction in the knowledge, skills and abilities deemed important for providing effective, ethical, and professional counseling services.
